Wage Compensation

- \$220.00/Day, Starting wage depending on experience.
- Day rate is based on an average of 10 hours per day.
- Accommodation and meals provided when working out of town. Meal prep shared.
- \$25.00/Day per diem for out of town work sites.
- Paid day travel to long distance project sites.

Key Responsibilities of the Role:

- Ability to take direction and demonstrate understanding, always adhering to trail standards, and asking for guidance when needed.
- Trail construction including layout, surveying, chain saw operation (must have training), cutting, swamping, limbing trees, root cutting, constructing rock armoured crossings, raking, shaping and de-rocking trails, constructing technical features from wood, rock and dirt.
- Improving drainage and aesthetics on existing trails, installing and removing sign posts, retaining walls, railing systems, and other infrastructure, rock drilling, mixing concrete and other anchor products and expanding grout.
- Carpentry work constructing bridges, boardwalks and TTFs.
- Perform minor maintenance on hand power tools (brush saws, chain saws, plate compactors) while out in the field and shifts end.
- Always adhere to the Lifetime Outdoor Safety Plan while on the job.
- Cheerfully interact with co-workers, sub-contractors, project managers and community users.
- Be punctual and reliable with a strong ability to work well with a team.
- Demonstrate safe work practices and mandatory use of PPE.
- Other duties as required.

Requirements:

- Functional knowledge of trail construction is an asset.
- Experience/certification in the use of a chainsaw and/or brush saw is preferred.
- Must be in excellent physical condition with the ability to work hard for 10hrs a day.
- Wilderness First Responder/Level 3 OFA is considered a strong asset.
- Must be able to work outdoors in all types of weather.
- Previous experience in landscaping, construction, carpentry or mechanical experience an asset.
- Valid driver's license is required.
- Be comfortable with travel and time away from home.
